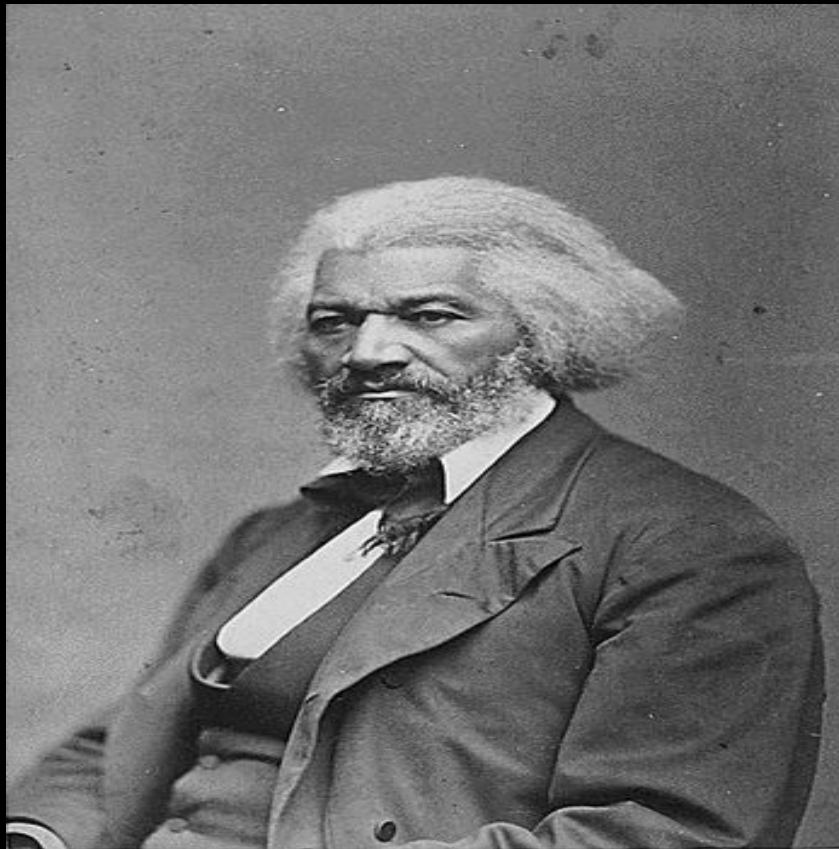


Cassey Album

- In January of 1850 Douglass contributed to Cassey's album.

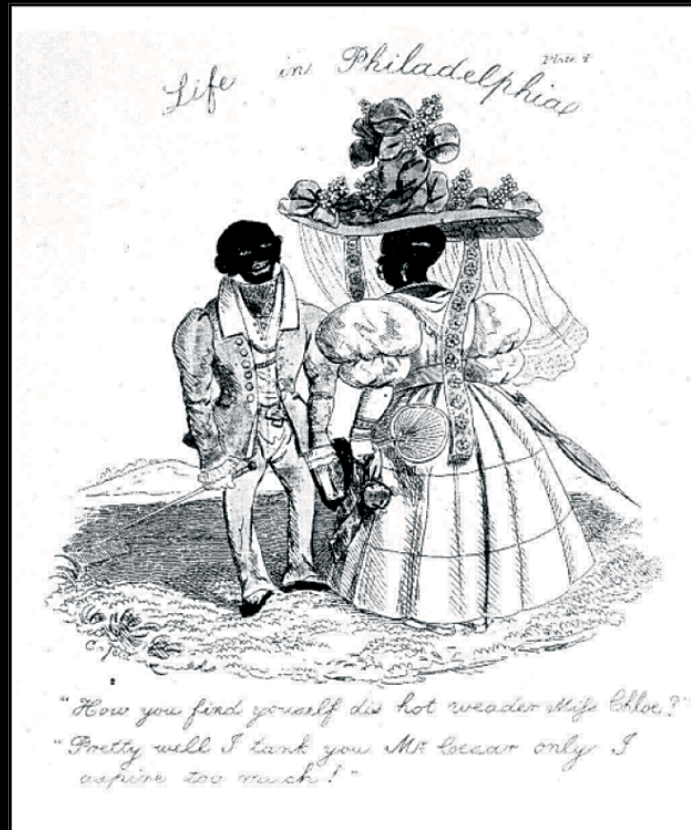
Black Women Abolitionists
